The three groundwater sustainability agencies (GSAs) in the Merced Subbasin (Merced Subbasin Groundwater Sustainability Agency, Merced Irrigation-Urban Groundwater Sustainability Agency, and Turner Island Groundwater Sustainability Agency-1) will host **two public workshops** to discuss a feasibility study for the potential connection of American Water's Meadowbrook Branch public water system, located in the Franklin-Beachwood area, to the City of Atwater, and/or the City of Merced public water system.
